

The New York Council on Nonprofits (NYCON), is hosting **New Executive Directors: BEING A SUCCESSFUL EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR LEADERSHIP RETREAT** to be held October 19-21 at the Desmond hotel, Albany, NY. Program Overview

Led by a multi-disciplinary team of experienced instructors, this retreat emphasizes real-world elements of nonprofit executive leadership, management and problem-solving.

Executives will be able to address both individual issues within their own organization as well as converse with other executive staff regarding their shared experiences and issues.
